2.	Old Business	<p>Updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spanish cohort updates (Diana & Crystal) <p>No updates have been received from CHW program in Washington State. Committee met earlier this month. CHW translation service is going to give a quote for translating slides. Discussed the importance of deadlines for moving forward. Modules will be extra material. New Jersey group has modules that are translated and culturally adapted.</p> <p>Comparison of the promotora modules (El Centro) – It is 13 years old. There might be an opportunity to integrate. The certification documents are only in English and El Centro is concerned about the level of understanding for promotoras. May be worth translating the Certification documents to be more inclusive of CHW.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UPenn CHW Education Program (Jackie Catron) <p>Barb reviewed the curriculum. They do not have service learning that is included. Content is similar. This topic should be transferred to the Certification Task Force. They have a capstone presentation as the assessment process. Difference between direct assessment (MARC Curriculum) and this type of indirect assessment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Community Health Representative Training <p>Diana spoke with Steffanna Rupnkicki, who connected her with CHR. They need to discuss with other leaders before sharing. Diana will follow up with this group.</p>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stroke and Heart Attack Risk Calculator – Possible learning idea. ASCVD Risk Calculator Can be used as a tool to guide treatment. May be a good topic to offer to CHWs as a tool. Dr. Moore could present on this. Mentoring Program <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Promote through the KDHE Peer groups Non-profits & faith-based organizations may be interested. This may be a good expansion of efforts that they already have. Symposium promotion through overview, table, etc. Target non-profits and health departments KC CHW Regional Collaborative Send to 2103 grant recipients. Maybe CHW profession is so new that there may be a need to help employers understand the need for a mentoring effort. This may be more appropriate a year from now.
