 - Shared with us information on how to sustain CHWS
 - Gave history of the CHCSEK
 - Shared how to utilize Medicaid SPA
 - Piloted a municipal court program
 - Helping people who have crimes of poverty
 - Working with the city prosecutor to engage with CHWs, and if they have progress, they get charges dropped
 - o 6 had charges dropped
 - o 9 are in housing
 - Population health
 - Working with local hospitals on ER usage and visits
 - Foster partnerships where there might be costs and where there is a need for much care- leveraged relationships with CHWs to help
